## **About Women in Forest Management:**

Women in Forest Management is an organization that exists to empower and connect women and those who support them. We work to foster an inclusive, professional, and collaborative industry by providing opportunities for professional development, networking, mentorship, and advocacy. Through our efforts, we aim to create a forestry sector where women's contributions are recognized, valued, and amplified.



Recent workforce shortages demonstrate the need to prioritize making our industry a more supportive and inclusive place where women's unique viewpoints are appreciated and welcomed. Comprising less than 20% of the workforce, women face many cultural, behavioral, and institutional challenges in forestry. We seek to be inclusive of women- and those that support them- that are working in all aspects of forest management as well as all forest management objectives. We are guided by six overarching values: collaborative innovation, environmental stewardship, economic and professional growth, workforce development and mentoring, community and engagement, and inclusivity and representation.

On March 1, 2024, Western Forestry and Conservation Association and Green Diamond Resource Company cohosted the inaugural Women in Forest Management meeting to assess interest in a group for women and allies in the industry. Sixty participants from across North America, primarily the Western U.S., attended. Since then, WIFM has formed a Board of Directors, adopted a guiding charter, received 501(c)(3) nonprofit status, and planned our first annual conference in February 2026.

Our Board of Directors is currently made up of seven women from Washington, Oregon and Idaho, representing industrial timber companies, state agencies, and universities. We intentionally cultivate geographic and disciplinary diversity across silviculture, operations, research, education, forest health, and resource protection. Our Board members are passionate about celebrating the achievements of women in forestry and recognizing allies who uplift them. Through collaboration with like-minded organizations, online resource sharing, and continuous engagement with women and allies, we aim to shape a culture that supports current and future generations in forestry professionals. Membership is open to anyone who is interested and there are currently no dues to join!

In addition to our annual conference, we host semi-regular meetups and happy hours and invite members to volunteer as hosts by contacting the email listed below. We are also developing a mentorship program to pair experienced professionals with those early in their careers; in the meantime, attend our in-person events to start building connections with potential mentors and mentees.
